General information on admission procedures

In case of the lower number of the applicants as is being planned to accept, a dean of the faculty can cancel the entrance exam.

In case of a higher number of the applicants as is being planned to accept, and if the entrance exam is being canceled, the criterion for the Bachelor study degree acceptance will be a high school academic achievement grade mean (respecting the results from the school-leaving exam).

The entrance examination for individual study programs

Psychology (Bc. degree) – for this study program, the conditions to be fulfilled are stated as follows: the applicant's selection is done by the means of written test covering the high school knowledge (from Psychology and Biology classes), the English language comprehension of B1 level while working with a text, the assessment of general intellectual abilities, i.e. solving of verbal, numerical, logical and abstract tasks, and a detailed analysis of the personality profile. The written tests are usual standard form of the entrance exams. The entrance test content respects the fairy-minded approach towards the education and the entrance exams do not exceed the high school content and scope. The entrance exam realization and its evaluation and result publication are guaranteed to be consistently anonymous by the means of the applicant's code and confidentiality of his/her name. Only after the computer base evaluation and independent and objective determined order, the applicants' names are being addressed to the codes.

Career opportunities for the graduates of the first level of university studies

Psychology (Bc. degree) – the first study degree graduate in the study field of Psychology (Bc.) is able to continue successfully in his/her studies in the second University study degree. The graduate is a personality to be able to realize supportive psychological activities of an assistant at various working-functional areas, such as in research, working, clinical, counselling, educational, and forensic and other ones.
