Programme description

The programme covers all significant research areas of translatology such as text interpretation and translation, schools of translation, various approaches to translation and interpreting, methodology of translation research, translation as communication, non-literary translation, literary translation, the history of translation in Slovakia, practical aspects of translation and interpreting, various genres of interpreting, teaching of translation and interpreting, computer assisted and machine translation.

Graduate profile

Graduates are qualified to work as professional researchers in applied translation research and are able to teach general translation studies as well as practical translation and interpreting courses at the university level. They are educated in translation history as well as in the latest trends in the field. They are able to predict trends in translation research and are well aware of theoretical concepts and intercultural models of communication.

Graduates can also work as translators, communication experts, theorists and professionals in public and mass communication.

Admission requirements

Applicants must hold a graduate-level university degree in the same or a similar field of study. Applicants will be selected based on a research project proposal including clearly described research methods, as well as a demonstration of wider knowledge and understanding of the relevant scholarly literature.

Programme courses are taught by accredited university lecturers, as well as researchers from SAV (the Slovak Academy of Sciences) and partner institutions in the Slovak Republic and abroad.
