

The Faculty of Law of MBU (FoL) in cooperation with the Faculty of Law and Administration of the University of Warmia and Masury in Olsztyn (UWM) in Poland offers one Master's degree joint study programme: Law

The joint study programme was created on the basis of the agreement between partnering institutions in 2012 which specifies organization and content/scope of the joint study programme. The joint study programme is based on the Master's degree study programme of Law at FoL of MBU and the Master's degree study programme of Law at UWM.

Students enrolled in the joint study programme attend courses from the recommended curriculum at the partnering university, taught in the English language, for which they obtain 30 ECTS credits.
