The project proposal represents European added value, at European and even at global level as it contributes to strengthening the cultural identity of the Slovaks in the diaspora, contributes to Europe's cultural heritage and by respecting diversity not only in Europe it supports tolerance towards all ethnic groups. The project will include transnational project meetings, identification and summarization of research carried out so far in Slovak dialectology, folk culture and scenic expression, as well as conferences, training, preparation and testing of didactic material and a preparation of practical guides prepared by foreign Slovaks.
