Prof. Peter Nijkamp is Dutch economist and unquestionably a top-class scientist of international renown. He belongs to the top 100 economists in the world according to IDEAS/RePEc (currently the position 13). He is an author or co-author of more than 500 scientific papers and 70 books with extremely high number of citations (almost 35 000 citations on Google Scholar). In 1995 his research group was evaluated as an international pioneering centre in spatial development research. The importance of his work lies not only inenriching international theoretical knowledge but also in their practical implications. About the quality of Nijkamp work, among many other things, testify membership in of Royal Netherlands Academy of Arts and Sciences and World Academy of Arts and Science. He has honorary doctorate from Free University Brussel, National Technical University of Athens, and Poznan University. He is holder of the most prestigious academic award in the Netherlands - Spinoza Prize.
