





EDUCATION CREATES THE FUTURE - BE THE FUTURE! MATEJ BEL UNIVERSITY IN BANSKA BYSTRICA

Matej Bel University was established on the 1st of July 1992 by merging the College of Economic Services and Tourism in Banská Bystrica and the Pedagogical Faculty in Banská Bystrica. Banská Bystrica has a long tradition of education and culture. As early as the 13th century there was a parish school and later a town school. In the 17th century a Jesuit grammar school was founded and it was soon followed by an Evangelical grammar school established in the same century. It was the latter where Matej Bel, who gave his name to the University, studied and later taught and held the position of the Rector.

Matej Bel (1684 – 1749) was the author of a large number of works about science, education, national history and geography, philosophy and religion. His ideas about the equal rights of nations, religious tolerance, of the integration of people and nations, of love of one's native country and his belief in the power of education and culture are still relevant. His works have contributed to the development of science, school systems, education and culture in Slovakia and Europe.

In the middle part of the 19th century, the Catholic grammar school, using Slovak as the language of instruction, became an important centre of education in Slovakia. In the academic year 1856-57, a Teachers' training college was founded in Banská Bystrica, where thanks to the then current Bishop Štefan Moyses, courses were provided not only in German and Latin, but also in Slovak.

In the academic year 1949-50, a branch of the Pedagogic Faculty of the Slovak University in Bratislava was established in Banská Bystrica. It was not until 1954 that the first institution of higher education – the Higher Pedagogic School – started its activities. Ten years later, on the 1st of September 1964, the Pedagogic Faculty came into being. In 1973, a branch of the Faculty of Commerce of the School of Economics in Bratislava was established in Banská Bystrica. In 1977 this became the Faculty of the Economic Services and Tourism. On the 1st July 1992, the Faculty adopted the new name – Faculty of Economics, which better characterised its main focus.



NATURE AND CLIMATE – A PARADISE ON EARTH

The territory of Central Slovakia partly encompasses two national parks – The Low Tatras (Nízke Tatry) and Great Fatra (Veľká Fatra), two protected landscape areas – Štiavnica Mountains (Štiavnické vrchy) and Kremnica Mountains (Kremnické vrchy), a number of smaller protected areas, Poľana biosphere reserve, protected areas, localities, mineral springs and geothermal waters.

The mountain and submountain character guarantees a great winter recreation while the basins and highlands are the paradise for summer hikes. Central Slovakia lies in the north temperate zone with regular changes of the four seasons. The continental climate is responsible for draughts, summer heat and winter frosts. The ocean air brings precipitation and moderates temperatures. The typical climate feature in the mountain areas is the temperature inversion mainly in spring and autumn. The average yearly temperatures range from 5.5 °C to 10 °C. The lowest temperature (– 41 °C) ever measured in the whole Slovakia was in the Zvolen Basin. Would you like to rest actively throughout the whole year? In our selection of activities you can find an adrenaline cruise on the Hron River, wind in the hair on long winter ski runs or water slides in waterparks.

Do you enjoy climbing every hill? Then you can choose from an enormous number of hiking and bicycle trails.

Central Slovakia is awaiting you with its high quality sporting grounds, ski resorts with modern facilities and thousands of kilometers of maintained running routes. Do you still need more adrenaline? We then recommend rock climbing, paragliding or an attractive hunt.
